





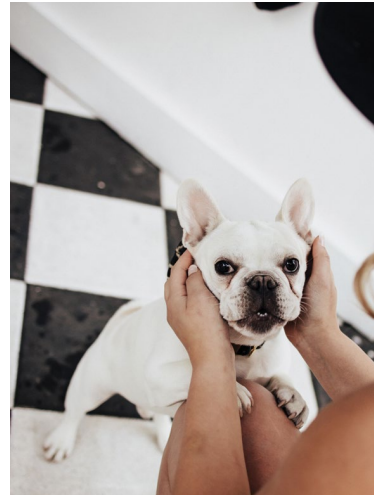
Elopement **ESSENTIALS**
