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Is the venue available on my desired date and time?



How long is the rental time?



What capacity does the venue offer?



Do you have any restrictions on food, decorations, or music at the venue?



Are there any additional fees associated with using the venue (e.g., cleaning costs)?



Are there any restrictions on the number of guests or type of vendors I can bring in?



Is there a backup plan if the weather is bad?



Is there an outdoor space available to host a ceremony or cocktail hour?



What is the payment schedule?

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What types of tables, chairs and décor are available at the venue?



Is there a sound system or audio equipment available to use in the venue?



Does the venue offer catering services or do we need to bring our own?



Are there any additional costs for parking or security services?



Do you offer discounts for off-season bookings, weekday, and/or morning weddings?



How much time do I have before and after my event to set up/break down the venue?



Are there any special discounts for returning customers or referrals?



Do you offer event planning services such as décor setup or entertainment booking?



Is there a designated area for bridal and groom suites?

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Are there any additional insurance policies I need to purchase in order to use the venue?



Does the venue have any contingency plans in case of emergency or unexpected disruptions?



Is there limitations or specific vendors that you allow? i.e. only using recommended vendor list?



Is there on site areas for getting ready for wedding party?



Is there sound ordinances that come into effect at night?



How long will you hold the date for us from when the proposal is sent?



Are we required to use your preferred vendors?



Do you require a wedding planner?



Are there any restrictions on taking photographs or videos in the venue? Or around the venue and add in a question about drones?
